Music Submission Guidelines:

- Submissions should be from genres represented by the music programs at KRVM.
- Songs submitted must be original, Bands/Musicians must own the rights to the music they are submitting and be willing to give Friends of KRVM and KRVM-FM the ability to reproduce, distribute and generate proceeds from the sale of the music on the 2017 KRVM Local Music Sampler.
- Bands/Musicians may submit up to 3 songs.
- Song submissions may be no longer than 5 minutes in length.
- Songs may contain no expletives and must be FCC friendly. KRVM wants to be able to play the selected songs on KRVM.
- Submissions can be demos, but should one of your submissions be selected for inclusion, KRVM will require a mastered CD or digital track in 16//44 wav format.
